- Maintain a successful Environmental, Safety, and Occupational Health Management System by:
 - Promoting the use of safe technologies and operating practices
 - Remaining ready and efficiently responding to emergencies
 - Improving Luke’s ESOH performance to minimize adverse impacts to human health, installation infrastructure, and the environment.
- Continually set ESOH goals: measure respective progress; take corrective action when necessary; communicate results and other ESOH information regarding the installation’s operations, concerns, and accomplishments to leadership, contractors, regulators, and the public/installation community.
