## Pilot released, flying operations resume

LUKE AIR FORCE BASE, Ariz. - The pilot involved in the incident Tuesday morning was

released from Havasu Regional Medical Center this afternoon.

Personnel from Luke Air Force Base are en route to the scene to begin recovery of the

aircraft.

An interim safety investigation board has been established for the incident and will

conduct a full investigation.

Flying operations at Luke Air Force Base resumed this afternoon after pausing for several hours.
