Christy Siddens is the Community Partnership Program Manager for the Community Initiative Team, Luke Air Force Base, Arizona. She manages the portfolio of major projects and programs in partnership with local governments, educational institutions, veteran service organizations, and other entities. The Public-Public/Public-Private (P4) Program's focus is to enhance mission readiness and quality of life by identifying efficiencies and reduce costs for mutual government and civilian benefit. She oversees the strategic development and negotiation of innovative partnerships and aligns projects and programs with organizational strategic goals.



Christy began her Air Force career in 2006 as a Palace Acquire Logistics Manager in the F-16 Supply Chain Management Group at Hill Air Force Base, Utah. During that time she also supported the Logistic Compliance Inspection Team (LCAT) as an inspector for Material Management functions along with providing inspection preparation and site inspections on Nuclear War Readiness Material facilities. She was promoted to the Aerospace Sustainment Directorate as the Acquisition Support Manager to oversee multiple logistic processes and functional developments within the Directorate. She then broadened her career working for Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) as the Customer Support Manager for all DLA Aviation Commodity requirements at Hill AFB. She returned to the Air Force accepting a newly created position within the Air Force Material Command (AFMC) as the Hill AFB Point of Contact to oversee their logistic hiring actions; to include developing new audit compliant process guides and hiring standards for 21 different Logistics Career Series positions. After this 3 year commitment and successful program rollout, she transitioned to the F-16 Foreign Military Sales Office as the Lead Program Manager; in support of the Acquisition and Sustainment functions of the Hill AFB, Taiwan F-16 Program. Christy transferred to Luke AFB in August 2020 to accept the position as the Community Partnership Program Manager.
