Blazon. On a disc Azure, two lightning bolts chevronwise Or throughout, surmounted at chief by a moneybag Argent, banded, detailed, and charged with a dollar sign Sable, superimposed by a stylized demi-coyote statant Brün, issuant from sinister, detailed and shaded of the fourth, eyed and teeth of the third, langued Scarlet; all within a narrow border Yellow.

Attached above the disc, a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "COYOTES" in Yellow letters.

Attached below the disc, a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "56TH COMPTROLLER SQ" in Yellow letters.

Motto. Coyotes

Significance. Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The coyote signifies the adaptability of the unit to overcome constraints and adverse conditions to accomplish the mission, just as the coyote adapts to its surroundings to survive. The moneybag reflects the fiscal responsibilities of the unit. The lightning bolt stands for the Squadron's quick and flawless execution of the mission.

Narrative.

The squadron was constituted on 14 June 1948 as the 56th Finance Disbursing Unit, Fighter, Jet. It activated on 1 August 1948 at Selfridge AFB, Michigan, under the 56th Air Base Group. It inactivated on 1 November 1949 and was disbanded on 9 August 1950.

On 15 August 1988, the unit was reconstituted, redesignated as the 56th Comptroller Squadron, and activated at MacDill AFB, Florida. It was assigned to the 56th Tactical Training (later, 56th Fighter) Wing. Initially, the squadron included the contracting function until 1 November 1991, when the 56th Contracting Squadron activated. In addition to taking care of the wing, the squadron was responsible for the day-to-day financial support of US Central Command and US Special Operations Command. The 56th Comptroller Squadron inactivated on 4 January 1994.

When the 56th Fighter Wing moved to Luke AFB, Arizona, on 1 April 1994, the squadron reactivated under the wing. Today the 56th Comptroller Squadron delivers world-class decision support on all financial matters while deploying mission-ready Airmen.
