**Significance.** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The eagle symbolizes the Air Force, holding the contract parchment representing the unit's mission of managing the formation of legal agreements in support of the parent wing.

#### Narrative.

On 28 October 1991, the 56th Contracting Squadron was constituted and activated on 1 November 1991 at MacDill AFB, Florida. It was assigned to the 56th Logistics Group until the squadron was inactivated on 4 January 1994.

When the 56th Fighter Wing moved to Luke AFB, Arizona, on 1 April 1994, the squadron reactivated under the group. On 27 September 2002, the squadron was reassigned to the 56th Mission Support Group when the group changed its name. Today, the squadron provides the best value acquisition capabilities while setting the standard in acquisition support.
