Attached below the disc, a Yellow scroll edged with a narrow Blue border and inscribed "56TH MEDICAL OPERATIONS SQ" in Blue letters.

Motto. None.

**Significance.** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The Staff of Aesculapius stands for hope, life and wisdom, as well as the unit's mission of providing quality patient health care. The alternating rays suggest twenty-four hour medical care.
