Reporting Options for Sexual Assault Victims (Adult)

Restricted

- The following individuals can accept a restricted report:
 SAPR Office and healthcare providers
- Available to military members, dependents (18+), and DoD AF Civilian Employees
- The sexual assault is NOT reported to OSI, MICO or Security Forces by the victim
- Victims may receive medical care (including SAFE kit), advocacy, counseling, and Victim's Counsel (VC)
- May change to Unrestricted at any time
- Victims may make a restricted report before or after an independent investigation is initiated
- Victims may anonymously enter subject information into CATCH

Unrestricted

- Victims may contact the SAPR office, law enforcement or anyone in their chain of command
- Available to military members, dependents (18+), and DoD AF Civilian Employees
- The sexual assault is reported to OSI, MICO or Security Forces by the victim
- Victims may receive medical care (including SAFE kit), advocacy, counseling, and Victim's Counsel (VC)
- Victims may request an Expedited Transfer and Protective Order
- Victims may anonymously enter subject information into CATCH if OSI is unaware of subject identity

Reporting Retaliation for Sexual Assault Victims (Adult)

Who is eligible?

For individuals who believe they have been retaliated against related to a sexual assault report:

- Adult sexual assault victim who has previously made an Unrestricted Report
- · Family members of adult sexual assault victims
- Witness or Bystander (who intervened)
- SARC or SAPR VA on the case; or Responder

CATCH a Serial Offender Program

The **CATCH Program** gives people making a sexual assault report where the name of the suspect is not known by law enforcement, an **opportunity to anonymously submit suspect information** to help the Department of Defense identify serial offenders.
