



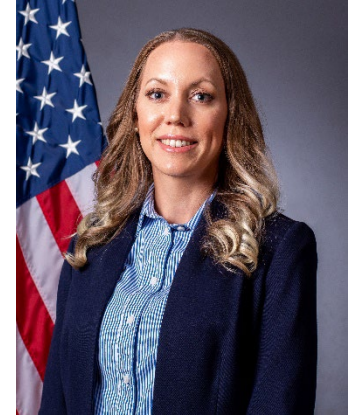
# BIOGRAPHY

### JENN RAHN

Jenn Rahn is the Senior Planner for the Community Initiatives Team, Luke Air Force Base, Arizona. She provides technical advice to base leadership on a full range of managed growth topics and mission sustainability matters for Luke AFB. She manages urban development surrounding the installation by working directly with cities, counties, State representatives, developers, and landowners. The Senior Planner's focus is to be a liaison between the 56<sup>th</sup> Fighter Wing Commander and surrounding political subdivisions, developers, and major stakeholders interesting in coordinating compatible land development in areas impacted by the mission goals.



Jenn began her Air Force career in 2020 as the Community Planner for the 56<sup>th</sup> Civil Engineering Squadron (CES). During that time, she managed the Airfield Certification and Waiver Programs for Luke AFB and the Gila Bend auxiliary airfield. As part of CES, Jenn was also tasked with the upkeep of the Installation Development Plan and corresponding Area Development Plans. She met with internal stakeholders across the installation to develop future projects and advocate for their funding prioritization. Jenn has served on several boards and working groups to include the Mission Sustainment Team and briefing the Facility Board. She then broadened her career working for the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) as Community Planner for 26 airports across Arizona and Nevada. In that position she managed Airport Capital Improvement Plans (ACIPS), grant funding, and Obstruction Evaluation/Airport Airspace Analysis (OE/AAA) cases. She served as the lead for interpretation of land patents, deeds, and other land transfer documents to verify appropriate aeronautical land use restrictions and regulations. She continued to work with Luke AFB regarding OE/AAA submissions around the installation. Jenn transferred back to Luke AFB in March 2023 to accept the position as Senior Planner.
